dear Sir

I would like to write to you this morning, and ask you for one thing, that is this, I like to go home from this school, I ask Capt. Pratt, about it, and he said, no and I thought I would ask you, one thing that I want to go home about it, nobody will take care of my things at home,

my mother, but she is old woman now and my father, died long ago, and only myself take care of those things, but my nephew want to come to school all the time, so I come with him, he has a sick what they call Consumption, after he been here and my folks

wrote to me and they want me
 to go home and I thought I
 wrote to you and let you know.
 I am old enough to make my
 own living and no body take
 care of my horses and cattle, had
 been issue to us, and I thought
 you will give me what I ask
 you. I like to go home all the
 time, I came from the Indian
 reservation in Crow Creek Agency,
 So, Dak. My mother send for
 me to go home, if you let me
 she will send me some money
 to go home with pay my own
 way home. Please let me hear
 from you soon
