The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:-

Replying to your letter of March 27th marked "Education, 12790," enclosing letter from Mr. and Mrs. Jacob A. Schanadore, Oneida, Wisconsin, asking for the return of their two children, pupils at this School, and directing me to make a report of the same with recommendation, I have to say that Thos. Schanadore came here first March 23rd 1888 and was sent home at the expiration of his term of five years, July 4th 1893. He returned for a second term of five years, or until he graduates, October 8th 1893. He is therefore not entitled to return home until 1898, or until he graduates if before that. Lillie Schanadore came here July 8th 1891 and is entitled to return home at the end of the school year in 1896. Both these students are in excellent health and there is therefore no reason why they should be returned. Their own interests are best served by their staying here, and ultimately, of course, the best interests of their parents. The letter of Mr. and Mrs. Schanadore is herein returned.
