

I have yours of May 31st, marked "Superintendent 22,543" covering Indian students from Klamath Agency, and have to advise you that I have written to Supt. Paine fully and advised him to wire me and hasten transfer of such party as he may be able to compass, in order that the expense of transfer, etc. may be covered by my appropriation this year. I find I have ample funds for sending my students home and bringing in all that we can accommodate, and would request your co-operation in order that we may consume as much as possible of our appropriation for the current year in this way.
