

In reply to your letter which I received yesterday, stating that my name has been furnished you as a candidate for the position as teacher in the Indian Service. I attended the Indian Industrial School Carlisle, Pa. 4 years & 8 months I graduated there in 1887. The Superintendent there is Capt. R. H. Pratt. When I returned to Onida I taught school 2 1/2 years. when the day school where I taught was discontinued on account of the new Boarding school gotten up on the reservation. Since then I have been expecting to get a position again in the Indian school. There is a vacancy near my home at present.
