


Dear Sir :-

I have written Mr. Collins and inaugurated the transfer for the 34 pupils from Osage, and hope it may be accomplished during the month of June. My authority to use the \$4000.00 for transportation of pupils, owing to a lapse in my letter requesting authority, was not worded so as to cover incoming pupils, and I have written the Honorable Commissioner requesting a rewording of the letter. Otherwise we are in good shape to accomplish it without further reference to the Office.

I have also written to Supt. Atkinson in regard to the party from Belknap. The Belknap students received five years ago were an exceptionally satisfactory party, and I should be glad to keep up our relations there, and trust that the prejudice may be overcome. I think the opposition to Carlisle was planted by a former agent.

I have made transcript of the report of Supt. Collins and herewith return the original.
