

Yours of the 1st instant relative to transfer of pupils is received.

There seems to be a mistake as to the meaning of my report, which was made on the regular blank and in accord with the printed instructions sent therewith.

The pupils named are ready for transfer so far as their studies are concerned, and as nearly as I can judge are in good health, but there has been nothing said to their parents about their going, nor have any of them expressed a desire to go, although I have talked Carlisle to them several times during the year.

I think it probable that some work among the parents would secure some of these for Carlisle.
