

Dear Sir :

Dr. Hailman, Supt. of Indian Schools, Washington, advises me that you wish to employ an Indian girl for the summer. I have to inform you that we have placed every girl available for the summer, and that we are over-burdened with applications, so that it is entirely impracticable for me to meet your wishes.

In this connection I must advise you that from past experience we have entirely abandoned the policy of letting our girls go into cities; so that on that ground also, I should be compelled to deny you.
