
Sir :

I return herewith the lists of students recommended for transfer from the Cheyenne and Arapahoe Agency, and have written to the Indian Agent in reference thereto.

In this connection, allow me to suggest that in getting out future report blanks of the same kind, it would be well if there was a column for character. I realize that while schools are for the purpose of making character, it is well for the non-reservation schools to be informed as to previous character. I also think it would be well if the reports were so arranged as to give information as to any previous attendance at non-reservation schools.

Lula Blind, an Arapahoe on one of these lists, was formerly a pupil at Carlisle, who was sent home on account of bad health. She was blind in one eye and had epileptic fits. I have advised Agt. Woodson of this.
