Sir:

I have the honor to state that I am in receipt of a letter from Capt. R. H. Pratt Supt. of the Carlisle Indian School, relative to the transfer of the 16 Indian Children of whom I made report to you in my letter under date of the 2nd Ultimo, also relative to the purchase of tickets &c. I have written him to the effect that I have not as yet obtained authority from you directing me to transfer the children without the consent of their parents or guardians, and further that I cannot very well make the transfer until some time in July on account of my quarters papers &c. While I cannot obtain the voluntary consent of their parents, I believe that I can take the children without very much fuss being made about it. *advise me.*
