Sir:-

Replying to your letter of the 21st marked 42691, enclosing letter from Wm. J. Tygar, graduate from Carlisle of the Class of '94 which letter is herewith returned, asking my estimate of him for a position of teacher in the Indian school service, I have to respectfully advise you that Mr. Tygar came here in September '93 and graduated the first of March '94. His conduct in the school-room was good, but outside of the school-room he betrayed qualities of character which prevent me from commending him to you as worthy of an appointment in the regular Indian school service. His short period at Carlisle did not enable us to put the stamp of Carlisle upon him with any material emphasis. He is practically white and has only one arm. The salary he claims to be receiving is fully as much as he would be worthy of receiving anywhere.
