Replying to your letter of March 7th marked "8705-6 Supt.

8789 " I have to respectfully advise you that Henrietta Fremont since graduation of the graduating class of 1895 has been a successful student in Swarthmore College ; that while at this school she was one of the best of our pupil teachers. I saw her at Commencement in the end of February last, and she seemed in good health. Her general health at the school throughout her history was good. Her character is very superior and she would make an exceptional teacher of her class.

Both Julia Elmore and Adelia Lowe had successful experience as pupil teachers during the latter part of their school period, and for good conduct and faithful service and ability, they have our warm commendation. Neither are very strong, but both were equal to their duties as pupil teachers and as students. Both have returned to their homes, Julia Elmore to Copley, Cal., and Adelia Lowe to Lander, Wyo.


I would suggest in their appointment, that it would be well for Julia Elmore to be in the vicinity of her home, in Southern Califor-




