Sir :-

Complying with the request in your letter of the 6th inst.

I respectfully state as follows, viz:

That for the position of Shoe and Harness maker at \$480.00, I have only one name to suggest, Perry Tsamawa, a Pueblo, who goes home this summer: he is a good workman and of good character. His only weak point and that will apply to all subsequent names on this list, would be the lack of that knowledge of quality and value of the stock required which comes through the Journeyman's experience.

For the position of Tailor at \$600.00 there are three who are competent, viz: Norman Cassadore, now working in Chicago I do not know how successfully; if doing well it would be a pity to disturb him: Stephen Smith of San Carlos Agency, Arizona, and Ernie Black, Cheyenne, now of Tongue River Agency, Montana.

Shoemaker at \$720.00. No one equal to this position.

Tailor at \$400.00. Either of the names given above, or David Turkey, now in <sup>Carlisle</sup> Bucks Co.; Joseph Martinez, Crow Agency, Montana; Rufus Ricker, Ft. Peck, Montana.

For Shoemaker at \$300.00. Josiah Red Wolf, Nez Perce; Joseph

The combined trades of shoe and harness making are not possessed by any except Perry Tsamawa who is a good hand at both trades as practiced here.
