
To the Honorable,  
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,  
Washington, D.C.

Sir:-

I find that through the expense of building the addition to our shops, and of building a laundry, and the larger amounts paid for transportation of pupils this year, because of the Trunk Line agreement prohibiting any but the regular rates, and the carrying of an average of 600 on the grounds from beginning of the year and 200 out, my appropriation is not going to be sufficient to meet the extra \$1800.00 paid for damages by storm explained by my letter dated Sept. 30th, 1896, and authorized by your letter dated Oct. 8th 1896, and marked "Finance, 37216, L. 37266, '96. Auth'y 49893."

I, therefore, respectfully request that as the \$1800.00 added an unexpected expense on account of storm, Congress be asked to add that amount to our appropriation for next year, and the same be made immediately available.
