Indian Industrial School.

Carlisle, Pa., March 15, 1897.

Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir,

Commencement and the consequent changes in classes, make it practicable for me to leave my work at Carlisle without occasioning any serious interruption in the work of the school.

It is my desire to take up, for the next three months, work in certain special lines of study at the Normal School in Oshkosh, Wis. where I was a student some time before entering the Indian service. I would respectfully ask that leave of absence, twenty one days with pay, the remainder of the time without - be granted me for that purpose, and that my name may remain upon the list of eligibles for reappointment at the beginning of the ensuing school year.

In consideration of my services at the Normantown day school, La Pointe Agency, and of the interest I take

in the Indians of that community, I very earnestly
desire that upon re-entering the service, I may re-
sume my position as teacher of that school.
