ORDERS:

A Board of Survey is hereby convened to meet on Tuesday, March 16th, 1897, at one o'clock P:M. to examine and report on the present actual condition and recommend disposal of certain property belonging to this School for which I am responsible which is no longer serviceable.

Detail for the Board: Mr. Elmer Snyder, Tailor, and Mr. Dennison Wheelock, Asst. Clerk, to act as Recorder.

The property will be divided into the following classes:

1st. Such as can be economically repaired and put to further use.

2nd. Such as can be used in maing repairs.

3rd. Such as would bring some reasonable price if offered at Bublic Sale and

4th. Such as is utterly worthless for any purpose and may be condemned to destruction.

The proceedings of the Board will be rendered in triplicate.

The Board met at one o'clock P. M. on the above date and proceeded to examine articles presented for its consideration, and find their condition as set forth and recommend that all be dropped from returns and disposed of as per tabulated statement herewith. The Board further finds that the property became unserviceable by fair wear and tear in public service and in its judgement is irrepairable.

We recommend that all materials, such as Blankets, cloths ec., which can be used for cleaning purposes about kitchens, Quartersand stables, instead of being destroyed be so used.

No further business the Board adjourned sine die.
