Replying to your letter of June 23, marked "Education, 24,442", enclosing letter from R.L. Moore, asking the return of his son, Rienzi, I have to respectfully report that Rienzi is now in the Senior class and will graduate next February; that he determined for himself to stay here, that he is a bright, modest, capable boy, and that under the system of the school he has the right to determine for himself. He has gone to the country for the summer under our Outing. There ought to be nothing in the father's disposition against the boy's self evident right course.
