I have the honor to forward herewith Government Request for transportation, account of Carlisle Indian School, ^{cl. 99505} #2226 dated July 25th. 1890 in favor of Hosea Locke and ten Indian pupils, using 10-1/2 tickets. The order was originally made to cover transportation from Ross Fork, Idaho, to Council Bluffs, Iowa, which is in accordance with "list of Agencies, nearest railroad stations, etc.," furnished by the Department. But there being no ticket office at Ross Fork the Agent at Blackfoot, Idaho, furnished the transportation and changed the order so as to read from Blackfoot, Idaho, to Council Bluffs, Iowa. The coupon I forward herewith reads from Ross Fork, Idaho, but the change is noted on the back.
