The complication in coal matters has hindered the delivery of the two thousand tons of Anthracite and I respectfully request that the authority to pay Indian boys for shoveling coal granted by your letter August 6, 1897, may be extended in that particular to include September. This not to increase the amount to be expended under said authority.

For the month of September I request to be allowed to pay two milkers, Indians, Five dollars (45.) each \$ 10.

For skilled mechanical labor required in making repairs
in masonry, machinery and similar expert work

We are going to be short in our clothing to outfit

boys this Fall and I request authority to hire 100 coats made

One dollar(\$1.) each, and 100 uniform pants at fifty cents

each
