I arrived safe and well to Carlisle September 3<sup>d</sup>, started my work and feel happy to be here again. It is a great pleasure to me to remember my western trip and I feel very grateful to you for giving me the chance to bring Sloyd to those far away places and to visit so many interesting cities and states. I wish to express to you my hearty gratitude for your kindness in general & your pleasant company, - I am very glad I was allowed to serve you and the Indian Schools.

I have recently had a letter from Miss Lagergren, the teacher I suggested for the Sloyd.

Department at Phoenix, Arizona. She would be very glad to accept the position and I think, would fit it well; she has been especially successful at her summer-school in Michigan this year and is highly recommended.

Yet, we have met with a difficulty: she is a Swede, has just taken out her first citizen paper, and was told that she can not take the civil service examination till after two years when she takes out the second. If so is the case she, of course, can not get the position at Phoenix unless she can be appointed as "extra teacher." I shall be thankful if you kindly will let me know soon what can be done in such a case, - if anything at all can be done.

I will soon make out my account for the journey this summer and send them to you. Hoping to hear from you soon, I am
