Sir:

Referring to your letter of the 30th ultimo about certain vacant positions at this school and suggesting names for them, I have to say that when the school was reorganized the 1st of September it became absolutely necessary to fill some of the vacant positions, and I obtained Department authority to do so temporarily.

Matters are now running in a satisfactory manner, and I do not wish to make any further changes, or anything looking to permanency, in the absence of Captain Pratt; and, therefore, suggest that things rest as they are now, pending his return 10 days or two weeks from this time.
