4th: All buildings are well supplied with piazzas. The large and small boys have in their respective quarters a large assembly room, used when necessary for recreation purposes. The girls' quarters has a large interior court surrounded with three large piazzas, and an assembly room each for large and small girls. There are also rooms for music practice, and a reading room at each of the quarters. The school is also provided with a large and well equipped gymnasium.

5th: Each employe's room is supplied with a double bed, mattress, two pillows, four pillow slips, two sheets, three blankets, one bureau, one washstand, three chairs, one rocking-chair, one carpet, and one set of chamber crockery; provided at the expense of the United States except in the case of the married employes who provide their own.
