Dear Sir:

Lilly Wind who came to this school from the Ottawas at Seneca, Mo., in 1882, and who remained seven years with us and then went to Hartford, Conn., where she graduated in 1891 from the Training School of Nurses, and has remained practising her profession since, writes me asking that I intercede with you for whatever may be due to her as a member of the Ottawa tribe.

She states that there is a proportion coming to her from the sale of the town site of Miami, and she thinks something besides. She says she has written to your Office, but gets no reply, and has also written to the agent without getting response. Her uncle, Mr. W.C. Jamison, of Miami, I.T., informs her that her share of this town site money went back to the Department at the time payment was made, because she was not present to receive hers, and because she was of age.

Lilly has been doing well as a nurse, and is perfectly competent to take care of whatever may be due her, and I recommend that her request be granted. She can be addressed at 54 Church St., Hartford, Conn.
