To the Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D.C.

Sir:

I am compelled to report that Mr. Charles C. Chadwick, Civil Service assignment to this school as Asst. Teacher on Nov. 1, who reported and commenced work on the 18th of November, is not competent, and his continuance is injurious to the progress of our school work. He does not apprehend the needs of his class; hears recitations but does not teach. His efforts are all merest book work. He does not secure effective action from his pupils, nor does he get them to express themselves. He is not a disciplinarian, hence there is disorder and idleness. He has been advised and urged to no purpose. It is not in him. He lacks assurance, knowledge of teaching and executive ability. I ask that someone be selected and sent in his place as early as practicable, and would not recommend his continuance in the Service.
