

Orders:

A Board of Survey is hereby convened to meet on Friday, March 18th, 1898, at one o'clock P.M., to examine and report on the present actual condition, and recommend disposal, of certain property belonging to this school, for which I am responsible, which is no longer serviceable.

Detail for the Board: Mr. H.F. Weber, Engineer, and Mr. Dennison Wheelock, Asst. Clerk, to act as recorder.

The property will be divided into the following classes:

- 1st. Such as can be economically repaired and put to further use.
- 2nd. Such as can be used in making repairs.
- 3rd. Such as would bring some reasonable price if offered at public sale, and
- 4th. Such as is utterly worthless for any purpose and may be condemned to destruction.

The proceedings of the Board will be rendered in triplicate.
