Hill, Wisconsin, desires her son, Walter Hill, to be returned to her as he has been at school three years, was received, but the letter referred to was not enclosed. Walter has been rather a bother to us, and something of a failure under our Outing, and needs just the discipline and holding to his work that he is receiving here.
