Replying to your letter of the 24th inst. marked "Supt.
23121 - 98, in regard to Alfred Laravie, I respectfully state that
Laravie entered Carlisle Oct. 1889, and was discharged April 1893,
having reached the 5th grade.

Not much has been heard of him since leaving Carlisle,
but here he was regarded as a boy of only ordinary ability and
character, good enough as a laborer, but not such a one as would
be selected to be placed in charge of others. What the last
four years may have done for him, I cannot say.
