

I have never written to you since I came home but nevertheless I have not forgotten you all. I want to thank you and all for what I have gained at Carlisle. All that I have learned there will be of great value to me for I now realize that I would never have gotten here what I have gotten there.

I came home after graduating but I have not been idle. I have been filling the place of assistant seamstress since the first of April. Although it is not what I want to do

It is better than not doing anything at all.

I was glad to see when I came home that there had been a great many improvements in this school since I went away. They are now building a new school house which they need very badly.

As I have always been interested in teaching I have sent in an application for appointment as teacher in the Indian Service. I am willing to go any where, where they might want me to go but for a year at least I would like to have that position here in our own school but

if I cannot get a position
here I am willing to go
any where. I know for
references they will go to
Carlisle.

This is all that I have time
to write now so I must
close hoping to hear from
you soon for I want you
to give me some advice.
