The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D.C.

Sir:

I find that the extra care Mr. Wheelock, my clerk and Bandmaster will be compelled to give to band matters will make it necessary to add extra help in my office.

I find that two of my Indian girls, who have been working in the office, can give the required help, and also add a necessary lift to the Outing Department. Keeping the records and corresponding with the many people who have our children, and also with the children themselves when out, has increased fully one-third the amount of work in that department since we found it necessary to have two clerks, and the time has come to give more help there.

I have put the boys' library and teachers' reference library together so that we might look more carefully after the books. This has increased the work in the Principal's office, and the assistant there should have better pay. It is important that the young people who fill these positions have better food than they get with the children. Heretofore, I have given each of them their rations with the students and \$10 per month.

To meet these several necessities, I respectfully request



that the salary for the assistant in the Outing Department be increased from \$10 to \$30 per month, and that the salary for the Library Assistant and the Assistant in my office be each increased from \$10 to \$25 per month, and they board and pay at the employes' mess.

These places are now respectively filled by Annie Morton in the Outing Department, by Sara E. Smith in the Library, and by Annie Kowuni in my office. I request that all these salaries begin with the first of September.
