

Sir:

Replying to your letter of March 25th marked "Education, 13432", directing that if I desire I can make arrangements for John Moses of Versailles, N.Y., to become a pupil of this school, I have to advise you that John Moses was married June 24th, 1898. He was then 24 years of age. He was examined by my school physician, Dr. Dixon, for Carlisle some years ago, and immediately after that ran away with his brother's wife.

I would suggest that a letter be written from the Office to John Moses stating that on inquiry it is found his age and character are such as to prohibit his admission to any Indian school.
