Sir:

I respectfully request your authority to expend at this school during the current quarter for irregular white and Indian labor the following amounts, viz:-

For the services of Asst. Clerk in place of Mr. Wheelock Clerk and Bandmaster, whose whole time is now occupied in training the Band of 60 pieces as explained in my letter dated January 5th, '99, 3 months, at \$40.00 per month, - - - - -	\$120.00
For the services of Asst. Carpenter 3 months at \$20.00 per month, in general repairs, - - - - -	60.00
For the services of Mason or Plasterer at repairs and instruction 30 days at \$2.50 per day, - - - - -	75.00
For making 100 Uniform coats at \$1.00 each, - - - - -	100.00
For making 100 pairs Uniform Pants at 50 ¢ each, --	50.00
For pay of Mail-carrier. 3 months at \$5.00 per month, - - - - -	<u>15.00</u>
In all, - - - - -	<u>\$420.00</u>
