Sir :-

Replying to your letter of Apr. 25th marked "Education" directing that I have Luella Cunningham whom I have employed temporarily as an assistant laundress, make application to the Civil Service Commission, I have to respectfully inform you that immediately upon beginning here Miss Cunningham wrote to the Commission for such blanks and I think her application has gone forward to the Civil Service Commission, though I am unable to state positively as we are under quarantine and she is not here at present. In regard to Lizzie James and Jennie Wolf, they as well as Ella Albert filed applications early in March and forwarded them to the Commission. They were returned about the middle of March for some informality, were corrected and forwarded again. So far as I know there is no reason why permanent appointments should not have been made in these cases some time ago.

I will look after Miss Cunninghams's case as soon as practicable.
