Referring to your letter of May 6th marked "Education 21008" advising me that Mrs. Roma F. Ewbanks of Holton, Kansas was not on the eligible list, the papers for the fall examinations for matrons not having been marked up to that time, I have to respectfully inform you that I wrote the contents of your letter to Mrs. Ewbanks and she expresses very great surprise thereat, and says she received her grades three months ago, and that her general average was 81.95. She states also that she requested to be placed on the registers of the three other districts besides her own, and received a reply dated March 6th, 1899, that her request had been complied with.
