

Referring to my letters to you dated March 15th. and April 10th., and your reply dated April 12th., marked "Education 16783 - 1899," concerning the insane boy, Miguel Maxcy, I have to respectfully advise you that in accordance with an arrangement made with Dr. W. W. Godding, Superintendent of the Government Hospital for the Insane, Washington, D. C., I sent Miguel to the above named institution, April 15th. The expenses incurred in taking the boy to Washington amount to \$7.69, as shown by account in triplicate herewith.
