
To the Honorable,

Sir:

During the summer months many of our larger boys and girls who other wise would be in the country earning money for themselves under our outing system, must remain here at the school and assist in the work on the school farms, in the workshops, at the new additions at the school building, storing the annual supply of coal, in the laundry, sewing room, quarters &c. &c. Some of these boys and girls are specially capable and will render efficient service.

I therefore respectfully request authority to expend \$1000.00 during the 1st quarter 1900, in the payment of student labor at rates varying from 10 cents to 50 cents per day, according to capability.
