
Sir:

Referring to your letter of August 16th, marked "Education-37890-99," in reference to the children of Peter St Pierre, I have respectfully to advise you that I am in correspondence with the Agent in reference to the whole party that came at that time, and will endeavor to settle it amicably.

The woman who brought the children states that it was well understood in the Agent's office that they were to come here for only three years, whereas, we have never had any one come here for less than a five years term, for the last fifteen years.

I have asked the Agent to submit the matter to all the parents, and if they all, or any of them, demand the return of the children in three years, I will return them.
