Sir:

I respectfully ask to have the salary of the Band Manager reduced from \$500 to \$120, and to have the salary of the Assistant Printer increased from \$480 to \$600, and out of what is left to have two pupils as Assistant Printers at \$60 each. These changes are necessary and in the best interests of the School and, as you can see, is a reduction of our annual salary list of \$140.
