Sir:

Owing to delay in receiving the material, Sky Blue Kersey &c., called for on the annual estimate and the large number of new pupils received, our stock of uniforms has fallen so low that it is beyond the resources of our Tailoring Department to replenish as speedily as should be. I therefore respectfully request authority to have made in town;

200 Coats at \$1.00 each, - - - - - \$200.00

200 pairs Pants at 50 cents each, - - - - - 100.00

Our drainage system is now nearly completed and all old vaults and cess-pools are to be abandoned and should be thoroughly cleansed first. I respectfully request your authority to expend for this purpose, - - - - - 150.00

In all, - - - - - \$450.00
