Sir:-

The facilities at the School Farm for the proper care of the large number of chickens kept are inadequate. I therefore request authority to purchase the following material for extension to chicken house and repairs to Farm fences at prices not to exceed those mentioned, viz:-

2000 ft. of German Siding at 27.50 per M, - - - - -	\$ 55.00
4000 Shingles #2, 24" at 9.00 " " - - - - -	36.00
1000 ft. Hemlock Boards " 18.00 " " - - - - -	18.00
150 Sawed fence posts, Oak " .30 " post, - - - - -	45.00
In all, - - - - -	<u>\$154.00</u>

Also to expend for labor as follows:-

For pay of Mason at Instruction and repairs, 30 days at \$2.50 per day, - - - - -	\$ 75.00
For pay of Plasterer at Instruction and repairs, 30 days at \$2.00 per day, - - - - -	60.00
For pay of additional Carpenter at fitting up new School-rooms &c., 60 days at \$2.00 per day, --	120.00
1 Painter 30 days at \$1.50 per day, - - - - -	45.00
In all, - - - - -	<u>\$ 454.00</u>
