
In 1886 we built in our School Shops a heavy Express wagon which has been our chief dependence for hauling freight &c. since that time, but is now getting old and our needs are large. I therefore wish to build another one as soon as we can do so, and ask authority to purchase the following material for the same;

1 Set XX wheels 2" & tire for, - - - - -	-\$ 25.75
1 " Steel axles & Felloe Plates, - - - - -	16.75
1 " Platform Springs, - - - - -	21.00

Also for the purchase of special material required in making special Spring wagons, Carriages and special Harness for Agency and School use when ordered by the Department, and for the pay of expert trimmer when needed at \$15.00 per week, 435.00

In all, - - - - - \$498.50
