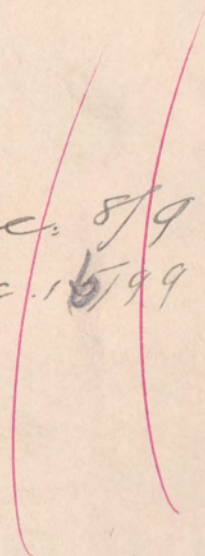


1 Garrison Flag, not to exceed \$30.00.
