
Sir:

During the past summer I received on contract with a local firm 200 Girls' Winter Coats, which proved to be a very advantageous purchase; so much so that when the time came to distribute, I concluded it best to supply all the girls with them instead of only a part, as at first intended, and have therefore arranged with the same firm to supply one hundred (100) more at the same rate, \$3.00 each.

We have now 427 girls on the roll, but part are supplied from their own purchasing and the additional 100 will supply our needs for this winter.

The season being so far advanced, I placed the order as above, for immediate delivery, and therefore request your authority to purchase 100 additional coats, under the existing Contract with Mr. John C. Behney, dated June 8th, 1899.
