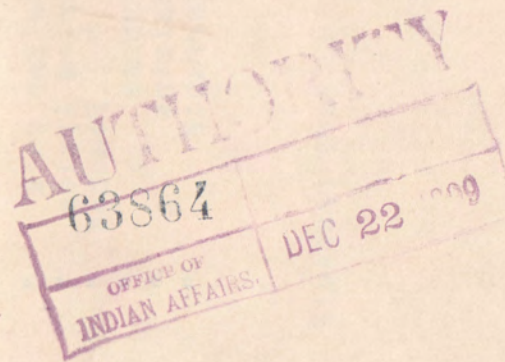

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

Your letter dated April 26th, 1899, Auth. 60916, authorizing me to publish an advertisement, inviting proposals for furnishing and delivering at this school sundry supplies required during the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1900, and to enter into contract for the same, included the following subsistence supplies:

6000 Lbs. Beans,	4000 Lbs. Hominy,
5000 " Rolled Oats,	3000 " Dried Apples,
3000 " Dried Peaches,	3000 " Prunes,
1000 " Raisins, and	300 " Currants,

all to be of the new crop of 1899.

The above named supplies were included in my advertisement dated April 27th, 1899, and dealers were informed that bids for the same would be asked for after the new crop was well on the market. Accordingly, I sent requests for informal proposals, November 1st. These proposals were opened November 10th, and awards were made as per schedule herewith.

The number of students having materially increased during the present fiscal year, our stock of these supplies was exhausted by November 10th, and it became necessary to purchase them at once as they


