

By many treaties, notably the treaties with the Sioux, Navajo, Apaches, Utes, Comanches, Kiowas, Cheyennes, Arapahoes, Ban-

nocks, Crows, Shoshones, and Pawnees it was arranged that the Government should provide educational privileges for all children between the ages of six and sixteen years, and this is as much a legacy to the children born since those treaties were consummated as the provisions giving allotments of land, rations, annuities, etc. and if the Government failed to provide the education the children were entitled to during the ten years between the ages of six and sixteen; and later on it becomes possible to give them their period of education even though they are far past maturity and willing to receive it, it seems to me unreasonable for the Government to withhold it. If the young Indians had intelligence and understood their rights well enough to bring their cases before the courts and demand from the Government the provision to attend school for ten years, even though it might be between the periods of 20 and 30; and they claimed that right because the Government failed to give them the privilege between six and sixteen as promised, equity indicates that the Government would be forced to comply. I understand very well that the rules referred to do not prevent young Indians above twenty-one receiving the benefits of the Indian schools, but the fact that there are rules indicates that denial of the right may be exercised; hence the statement of these views. Put upon the broader basis of the great need that all our people shall be sufficiently intelligent to exercise the responsible duties of citizens, there can be no question of what the duty of the Government is to its wards.
