

Sir :-

Replying to Circular #36, marked "Education" dated the 21st, I have to respectfully advise you that board at our school mess costs the uniform price of \$2.50 per week. There is enough saved from this to keep the mess provided with table linen, dishes and kitchen furniture. We employ a matron at \$30.00 per month, a cook at \$25.00 per month, and pay Indian girls about \$30.00 per month out of this.
