To The Honorable,

The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir :-

Replying to your letter marked "Education 9179" dated the 27th ult., I have to respectfully advise you that at the same time I wrote you of Miguel Maxcy's condition I wrote Dr. A. V. Richardson, Supt. of the Govt. Hospital for the Insane in Washington, from which he had been dismissed. Three days ago I received the Doctor's reply stating that he thought his return to insanity was due to excitement and that his cure had not been sufficiently established, and suggested that I return him to the hospital again I accordingly sent him back under the care of my school physician and one of my Indian boys to help. I informed Dr. Richardson that the Govt. Asylum for Insane Indians had not been constructed and that when it was constructed I would suggest Miguel's transfer to that as the proper destination of all such Indian cases.
