The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Washington, D. C.

Sir:

In harvesting our potatoe crop last year it was found that the supply would not be sufficient for the whole year but would last until the spring, and I thought best to leave the purchase of the additional needed until that time and save the loss of keeping a large stock over the winter. I find that for subsistence and seed we will need 400 bushels of potatoes that can be bought now at 60 ¢ per bushel. We will also need some additional dried fruit and other articles made necessary by increase in number of pupils &c. I therefore request authority to purchase in open market the following articles, viz:-

400 bushels of Potatoes at 60 ¢, - - - - -	-\$240.00
1000 lbs. Dried Apples " 7-1/2 ¢, - - - - -	75.00
500 ft. Dongola Kid. Leather at 16 ¢ per ft., --	80.00
600 " Satin Calf " " 15 ¢ " " --	<u>90.00</u>
In all - - - - -	\$485.00
