

To the Honorable,
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,
Washington, D. C.

Sir:-

By action of Board of Survey two of our horses which had become old and unserviceable were condemned; they need to be replaced by a span of heavy dray animals and I respectfully request your authority to purchase such a span of horses or mules at a cost not to exceed \$300.00, and that the same be paid for from the appropriation for stock for Indian Schools. If this is not practicable, then to pay for them from the Carlisle appropriation for the current year. I also request authority to purchase in open market 250 bushels of corn needed for subsistence of Government animals until the new crop comes in, at a cost not exceeding 50 ¢ per bushel, or \$125.00; in all - - - - - \$425.00
