
I respectfully request your authority to expend for labor and repairs during the current fiscal year, the following amounts, viz:-

✓ For	1000 lbs. White lead at 6¢	-----	\$ 60.00
"	Plasterer, 30 days at instruction and repairs, at \$2.00 per day,	-----	60.00
"	Mason, 30 days at \$2.50 per day, for instruction, and repairs,	-----	75.00
"	Cook at the Farm 3 months, at \$10.00 per month.	--	30.00
"	Pay of two boys at the School Farm at \$6.00 per month each for 3 months, and one boy at \$5.00 per month for 3 months,	-----	51.00
✓ "	Incidental repairs to buildings and machinery, water, steam and drain pipes, electric system &c.,	-----	<u>200.00</u>
	In all	-----	\$ 476.00

The item of cook at the Farm becomes necessary by reason of the boys who are employed at the Dairy taking their meals at the Farm, instead of at the School, for the greater convenience and saving of time.

The boys for whom pay is asked are employed at the farm 3 miles distant from the School and work all day. hence the pay for them making it equivalent to the country outing.
