
The Commissioner of Indian Affairs,

Sir :-

The transfer of Miss Luckenbach to Phoenix leaves a vacancy in the clerical force of this school. Employees in other positions who are qualified to fill the place are too important in their own. This position has charge of the savings of all pupils, keeping their accounts and overseeing the proper expenditure of their earnings. The position now appears and has been asked for the succeeding year as "Clerk" at \$720.
