10. Are you physically strong enough for the duties of the position to which you seek appointment?	I feel sure that I am.
11. Have you any defect of sight?	I have no defect of sight.
12. Have you any defect of hearing?	I have no defect in hearing.
13. Have you any defect of limb?	I have no defect of limb.
14. Have you any defect of speech?	I have no defect of speech.
